Telephone bids or computerized bids will be accepted 24 hours each day, 7 days per week.

Manual Bid Requests will be accepted by the Station & Branch JBM.

To submit Manual Bid Request: Utilize Form 1717-A, or a piece of paper with your name and EIN, noting in order of preference, position number(s) you wish to bid; sign your name at end.

If technical difficulties are experienced when bidding, immediately notify Station & Branch JBM by phone at 412-359-7773. **Immediately follow up notification with a manual bid request.**

Interested employees are requested to thoroughly review the qualification standards, duties, and responsibilities before making application.

Assignments will be made to the senior qualified employee. Carriers will be required to work the routes and work schedule awarded, and to perform all duties of the position. Route Adjustments will not invalidate the bid.

Per Article 41, Section 1A2, of the National Agreement, Carrier Craft members are ineligible to bid on carrier vacancies while detailed to a temporary supervisor position (204B).

Carriers bidding on vehicle routes (Collections, Parcel Post, Mounted & Park & Loop routes) must have in their possession a current valid state driver's license. Any employee who is the senior bidder on a vehicle route that does not possess a current valid state driver's license will not be awarded that bid.

The Begin time and End time for each vacant route immediately follows the posted route. Time shown is 24-hour clock system. Work Schedule is shown, with Begin Tour, End Tour, period allowed for lunch, and layoff days. Lay-off days rotate on most positions; exceptions noted by showing two days rather than Su-ROT

THE LAW (39 U.S. Code 1002) PROHIBITS POLITICAL AND CERTAIN OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS FOR APPOINTMENTS, PROMOTIONS, ASSIGNMENTS, TRANSFERS OR DESIGNATIONS OF PERSONS IN THE POSTAL SERVICE. Statements relating solely to character and residence are permitted, but every other kind of statement or recommendation is prohibited unless it either is requested by the Postal Service and consists solely of an evaluation of work performance, ability, aptitude, and general qualifications of an individual or is requested by a government representative investigating the individual's loyalty, suitability, and character. Anyone who requests or solicits a prohibited statement or recommendation is subject to disqualification from the Postal Service and anyone in the Postal Service who accepts such a statement may be suspended or removed from office.

Per Memorandum of Understanding:

- A.) A regular letter carrier who is temporarily disabled will be allowed to bid for and be awarded a letter carrier bid assignment in accordance with Article 41, Section 1C1, or, where applicable, in accordance with provisions of a local Memorandum of Understanding, provided that the letter carrier will be able to assume the position within six (6) months from the time at which the bid is placed.
- B) Management may, at the time of submission of the bid or at any time thereafter, request that the letter carrier provide medical certification, indicating that the letter carrier will be able to perform the duties of the bid-for position within six (6) months of the bid. If the letter carrier fails to provide such certification, the bid shall be disallowed, and, if the assignment was awarded, it shall be reposted for bidding. Under such circumstances, the letter carrier shall not be permitted to re-bid the next posting of that assignment.
- C) If at the end of the six (6) month period, the letter carrier is still unable to perform the duties of the bid for position, management may request that the letter carrier provide new medical certification indicating that the letter carrier will be able to perform the duties of the bid-for position within the second six (6) months after the bid. If the letter carrier fails to provide new certification, the bid shall be disallowed, and the assignment shall be reposted for bidding. Under new circumstances, the letter carrier shall not be permitted to re-bid the next posting of that assignment.
- D) If at the end of one (1) year from the placement of the bid the letter carrier has not been able to perform the duties of the bid-for position, the letter carrier must relinquish the assignment, and shall not be permitted to rebid the next posting of that assignment.
- E) It is incumbent upon the letter carrier to follow procedures in Article 41.1.B.1 to request notices to be sent to a specific location when absent. All other provisions relevant to the bidding process will also apply.

An employee who is temporarily disabled and declared the “SENIOR BIDDER” must provide medical certification indicating that he/she will be able to perform all the duties of the position bid for within six (6) months of the effective date.

Employees who fail to provide the documentation by the deadline date will remain in their current assignment and the position will be posted for bid, and the letter carrier shall not be permitted to re-bid the next posting of that assignment.

It is the responsibility of the employee to send the documentation for receipt within twenty-one (21) days from effective date on award notice.

REQUIREMENTS

EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must successfully complete the Virtual Entry Assessment MC (474).

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be physically able to efficiently perform the duties of the position, which require arduous exertion involved prolonged standing, walking, bending and reaching, and may involve handling heavy containers of mail weighing up to the allowable maximum mailing weight.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS:

City Carriers must work their assigned tour and days of work. City Carriers must follow Postal Service policies and procedures for personal conduct at work, including adhering to rules and regulations.

City Carriers are required to provide service to the public. They must maintain a neat and professional appearance and demeanor in such interactions, including wearing an approved uniform.

Applicants must have a valid state driver's license, and demonstrate and maintain a safe driving record.

As principal carrier for a designated group of not less than 5 letter routes, delivers mail on foot or by vehicle on the routes in his group during the absence of the regularly assigned carrier, and provides job instruction to newly assigned carriers.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

See the Standard Position Description for the Occupation Code given above.

REQUIREMENTS:**EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:**

1. At least two years of postal experience, of which at least one year must have been in the performance of city carrier duties.
2. Successful completion of a 4-year high school curriculum may be substituted for one year of the required experience, but not for the one year of experience as city carrier.

Note: The required amount of experience will not in itself be accepted as proof of qualification. The applicant's record of experience and training must show the ability to perform the duties of the position.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, & ABILITIES REQUIREMENTS:

This section is composed of Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities (KSAs) which are required to satisfactorily perform the tasks of the position. Applicants must demonstrate that they possess a sufficient level of each KSA, to include at least minimum competency for senior-qualified positions to enable them to perform these tasks satisfactorily. Applicants demonstrate these levels by describing examples of experience, education, or training, any of which may be non-postal. Ratings are based on the demonstration of the level of possession of each of the KSAs. Failure to demonstrate any KSA is disqualifying.

1. Ability to use reference materials and manuals particularly as it relates to city delivery service.
2. Ability to instruct new carriers in the office and street duties and responsibilities of a city carrier.
3. Ability to work independently.
4. Ability to work with carriers in improving delivery service and in maintaining cooperative relationships with customers.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Applicant must be physically able to perform efficiently the duties of the position.
